

3.0 The Aims and Objectives of this Trust





4. Constitution and Management of the Trust


- 4.1 The Trust shall be managed and administered with reference to the true spirit of achieving its aims and objectives. The Trust can be operated anywhere in India.
- 4.2 The Trust shall be managed by Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall consists of the Founder Trustee (president) and the Main Trustees above mentioned and / or any other trustees appointed from time to time as per the provisions of clause 5.1 of this Trust Deed.
- 4.3 The managing committee consist of the President (Chairman), Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. The Founder Trustee and his /her legal heir shall be the Chairman of the Trust and the Vice-President/ Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected out of the Main Trustees only and the other office bearer shall be elected out of all the members of the board of Trustees. The term of the managing committee is 5 years or till the new managing committee is appointed by the Board of Trustees.

4.4 The managing committee shall act as per guidelines/ directions issued by the Founder Trustee (President) from time to time and in the absence of President, Vice-President has the power of attorney.

5. Powers, duties and liabilities of the Trustees

- 5.1 The Founder Trustee or President (Chairman) and his /her legal heir shall be entitled to appoint by his/her unanimous decision, additional trustees who are likely to contribute to the objectives of the Trust and coordinate in carrying out the aims and objectives of the Trust, provided however the total no. of Trustees including the Founder Trustee, Main Trustee shall not be exceed Five. If however the Board of Trustees deems if necessary in the interest of the Trust to increase the no. of Trustees to more than Five, A special General Body of the Board of the Trusties shall increase the same to such number as they deem it necessary.
- 5.2 The Founder Trustee (chairman) entitled to hold his/her office for the life or till he/she voluntarily retires or other Founder Trustee/Main Trustee shall fill up his resign and such vacancy to his/her office by a majority decision.
- 5.3 Any Trustee becoming bankrupt or punished by a court for any offence involving moral turpitude or becomes insolvent or any Trustees other than Founder Trustee and Main Trustees remains absent without the prior permission of the Board of Trustees for three consecutive meetings or resigns from his/her post or found to be working detrimental to the interest of the Trust or its objects or otherwise becomes incapacitated either physically or otherwise, shall become liable to be disentitled or removed from the post of the Trustee by the majority decision of the managing committee.
- 5.4 Any of the Trustee may retire after giving a prior notice of each one month in writing of his/her intension to do so to each of the other Trustees and upon determination of such month's period, the Trustee giving such notice shall ipso-facto cease to be the Trustee of the Trust.
- 5.5 The Main Trustees or the Founder Trustee or the Trustees shall not be liable for any losses to the Trust in whatsoever manner provided not due to guilty of conduct or fraud by concerned Trustee or Trustees.



6. Meetings

- 10-

- 6.1 The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as required by the meeting of Trustees but positively there shall be an annual meeting when annual audit statement of accounts shall be considered and adopted. The president shall at such meeting, place before the Board, a report on the working of the Trust and Budgeted expenses for the coming year or in the absence of President, Vice president has a power to conduct meetings and take the decisions as per the direction of president.
- 6.2 Prior notice of seven days shall be given to the Trustees for the meeting of Board of Trustees. The Trustees shall however have the powers to waive the issuance of prior meeting of such meeting.
- 6.3 in case of urgency, the President (Chairman) shall be entitled to, without holding a meeting, circulate the matter to the Trustees for the opinion of the each of them and the opinion of the majority in support of a proposition circulated shall be deemed to the resolution of the Board.
- 6.4 The meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at the registered office of the Trust or at any other suitable place as decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time.
- 6.5 The quorum for a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 2 Trustees or 1/3 rd of the total no. of Trustees, whichever is higher. The President (Chairman) shall preside all meetings. In the absence of the President, the vice president has power to do the functions of the president. if both are absent, Trustee elected one, among the Main Trustees shall be entitled to do the functions of the President (Chairman) for the day.
- 6.6 A minute book shall be maintained at the office of the Board of Trustees, minutes of all proceedings, appointments and entry into the office of every new Trustee and other proceedings shall be entered and recorded in such minute book and shall be signed by the President/vice president of the meetings, either at the conclusion thereof or a subsequent meeting which are duly confirmed.
- 6.7 The decision of the Board of Trustees shall bind the Trust and its members and such decisions shall be carried out or implemented effectively.



7. Administration

The Trust and its units shall be administered by the managing committee subject to the guidelines/directions issued by the President/vice president from time to time. The President/vice president has the powers to direct the managing committee to alter, modify or cancel any decision taken by it.

7.1 Without prejudice to the generality of the powers, the President shall have the following powers in carrying on the objects of the Trust.

7.1 a. To employ employees, agents, bankers, lawyers, accountants, doctors, nurses and others as are necessary for the successful functioning of the Trust on such remuneration, fees allowances, etc., as they think fit.

7.1 b. To delegate any powers as they can lawfully delegate to any other person and to execute such power as they may think fit for the purpose.

7.1 c. To acquire, to bye, to encumber, to sell or to otherwise dispose any of the properties, movable or immovable including investments, reinvestments etc.

7.1 d. To withdraw any power or remove appointment of any employee or attorney.

7.1 e. To let any portion of immovable property forming part of the Trust property at such rent and for such period and on such terms and conditions as they may think fit and accept surrender any lease, without violating any provision of the Income Tax Act 1961.

7.1 f. To maintain bank accounts in the name of the Trust and the same may be operated by the President, however, the President shall have the power to delegate the operation of the accounts to any other Trustee/person for such period as the President deems fit. The managing committee may authorize to open any bank account/s in the name of the institutions/units run by the Trust and such bank account/s shall be operated by the President or by his/her nominee.



- 7.1 h. The Founder Trustee (President) are empowered to borrow money from banks, financial institutions or other persons, with or with interest and with or without security, as they deem fit for the purpose of carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust.
- 7.1 i. The Founder Trustee (President) have the power to overtake or purchase any already running institutions or sick institutions or other trust or society management interested to handover their institute.
- 7.2 The powers conferred herein above shall be so exercisable by the managing committee concerned to ensure that the income of the Trust would be exempt under section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 read with section 12 and 12 A, as amendment from time to time or any other provision of the laws relating to Income Tax. It is Clarified that powers of investment of the Trust funds shall be exercised in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and other applicable laws in this regard.
- 7.3 The Trustees shall be entitled to reimburse out of the Trust estate all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or powers herein or in carrying out the activities of the Trust, its objects and affairs for the relatives, preservation or benefit of the Trust properties. The Trusties shall be entitled to be indemnified by the Trust properties against the consequences so all lawful act done by the Trustees in the course of and discharge of their duties as the Trustees of this Trust and against all cost expenses thereof.
- 7.4 The Trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration and shall work in honorary capacity. They shall however, be entitled to receive the amount towards out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the activities of the Trust.
- 8. Number of bank account/s may be opened in such bank or banks as the case may be, as decided by the Board of Trustees in their meetings from time to time in the name of "Shri Basava Education Trust".

9. Trust property

9.1 The Trustees may, at any time, invite or without invitation, receive any voluntary contribution or contributions either from the Trustees or from any other person or persons. Either by the way of donations, legacy or otherwise.

9.2 All such contributions received or accepted shall be treated as forming part of the Drust fund.

9.3 The Trustees shall however, always be at liberty to decide at their discretion, whether to invite and /or accept any such contribution and they at all times shall be at liberty to refuse any contribution without giving or assigning any reasons for such refusal.

9.4. The Trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount corpus and such other properties (both movable and immovable) may be acquired from time to time by the Trust by purchase, exchange, grant, subscription, endowment, donations, contribution or any manner whatsoever – all which shall be designed as "The Trust Properties" of the Trust herein mentioned. Only the income derived from the Trust properties shall be utilized for carrying out the objects of the Trust.

10. Depositing Funds and Application Income

The funds of the Trust shall be invested in the modes specified under the provision of section 13(1) (d). Read with section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time. The trustees shall also have the powers to vary, subject to the above said statutory requirements; the investments from time to time and for the purpose, may sell or realize any of the Trust properties.

The income derived and the property acquired for the society shall be applied solely for the promotion of the aims and objects of the Trust as set forth above to all persons irrespective of nationality, community, caste, creed, color, religion, and sex and for the payments of remuneration to any officer or employee of the Trust or any other persons in consideration of any service rendered to the Trust and no portion of it shall be distributed by way of dividends, profits etc., to the trustees.

11. Accounting

- 11.1 There shall be maintained all accounts of the Trust regularly. A Chartered Accountant shall duly audit the Accounts and a Certificate obtained.
- 11.2 The Accounting year of the Trust shall be from 1st day of April of a year ending with the 31st day of March of the succeeding year, the accounts shall be closed by 31st March.

12. The Trust shall not be entitled to carry on any business of profit in the course of carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust mentioned hereunder.

13. The funds and the income of the Trust shall be solely utilized for the achievement of the aims and objects of the Trust mentioned hereunder.

14. The Benefits of the Trust shall be open to all irrespective of Caste, Creed, Color, Religion or sex.

15. Amendments to Trust Deed

The terms and conditions of the Deed of Trust may be amended by the President(chairman) and Main Trustees on the recommendations of the Managing committee for the time being by a majority decision of three fourth(3/4). However, no such amendment shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of section 2(15), 11, 12 & 13 and 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further, no amendment of the objects for which this Trust is created shall be carried out without the approval of the commissioner of Income Tax.

16. Trust is irrevocable

The Trust is a public charitable institution and in no case the property of the Trust shall be reverted for the personal use of the Founder President or other Trustees or their heirs or others or donors and no part of the income shall be used for the benefit of the Founder President or other Trustees or their legal heirs or donors. The executives of the Trust shall have no power to revoke the Trust and shall be irrevocable.

17. In the event of the determination or dissolution or winding up of the Trust for any reason, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall be transferred to another charitable Trust whose objects are similar to those of this Trust which enjoys recognition under section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

18. Any matter specially expressed in these presents, the provisions of the Indian Trust Act, shall apply.


